What the position involves (accountabilities)

Job Specific

Weld (MIG and TIG) alloy boats and boat components ensuring a high quality finish in terms of both strength and appearance, so that minimal rework is required.

Set up welding machines and equipment, and accurately follow drawings to determine job requirements and ensure all boats and parts are built to specification.

Clean and smooth welds by filing, chiselling and grinding.

Inspect completed welds for accuracy.

Maintain all equipment in good condition and ensure your work area remains tidy.

Ensure all work completed is of a high quality and in line with Stabicraft standards, by following the DPS and job card instructions accurately.

Work efficiently and accurately so that tasks are completed within standard timeframes.

Continually aim to improve your own output and quality and reduce waste and rework.

Actively offer ideas and suggestions for improvements to the way we work including systems and processes.
